Music You Love. Musicians You Know. VSA Chorus to Close Season 53 with Earth Week Celebration Concerts "WATER! Find the River"

MONTROSE, CO – The Montrose Pavilion will come alive on Saturday, April 26 and Sunday, April 27, as the Valley Symphony Association (VSA) Chorus joins forces with concert partner Colorado Outdoors to present "WATER! Find the River" for the grand finale of Season 53. Traditionally held in March, the standalone VSA Chorus concert has shifted to April this year to align with Earth Week festivities and the spirit of spring. In addition to the VSA Chorus, numerous regional musicians—including the newly formed Valley Youth Chorus—will grace the stage. Audiences can expect a powerful and uplifting program that reflects the beauty of the natural world and the importance of water as a life-giving force.

She added, "When I think about bringing these elements onstage together to tell this story, I want to cry. I feel so connected to what music is and what it can do. It is the greatest privilege to weave this vision into reality and share it with my community."

This unique collaboration between the chorus and Colorado Outdoors will highlight themes of renewal, growth, and environmental awareness, marking the beginning of the water season in the region.
